Naloxone Co-payment Assistance Program

Naloxone is an emergency medicine that can stop an opioid overdose.

Do you have prescription coverage as part of your health insurance plan? If you do, you can use N-CAP to cover up to \$40 in prescription co-payments so there are no or lower out-of-pocket expenses when getting naloxone at a participating pharmacy.



Many New York State pharmacies provide naloxone through a “standing order” which means you can get the medication at these pharmacies without a prescription from your doctor. To find the nearest registered program or participating pharmacy, please visit: www.health.ny.gov/overdose
